Happy Father's Day

IS HE YOUR FATHER TOO?

"Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?" (Matthew 6:26)

We welcome everyone today to our annual celebration of Father's Day. After the morning service, we invite everyone to stay and enjoy fellowship around a hearty meal prepared by the Berean Baptist family.

I know there are many of you that will think how blessed you are to have known the joy of a godly father, while others will not think so fondly on this day because of your disappointment in a father that may have in some way abused or even abandoned you. For this reason, we offer you the unsurpassed joy of having a heavenly Father that will love you and care for you like no human Father ever could. Jesus speaks of the Father's care and compassion in Matthew chapter 6. He said the Father feeds the fowls of the air and clothes the grass in the fields; if so, how much more does He care for those that are His own? If He takes care of insignificant plants and animals, will He not care for those He purchased through the death of His own Son? While there is a sense in His common grace that He provides for all people, His special grace of relationship that grants for us a heavenly home with Him is only available to a certain subgroup made up from people of all kindreds, tribes, and nations.

Here is the critical factor you must know: God is the Father only of those who have received the pardon of their sins through faith in Christ. His offer of mercy, compassion, and love are extended only to those who understand how wretched they are without it! None of us deserves to be cared for in this way, but God did not send Christ because we deserved it. He sent Him to die for us because it is His character to be merciful and to love humanity even though we have so miserably failed Him. He sent Christ while we were hostile towards Him, living in the sinful desires of our flesh. He knew we would never come to Him unless He first came to us.

There are so many wonderful aspects of our Father's character. He never disappoints. His great benefits are in bountiful supply so that we are never in want. Our fathers may fail us and even the best are mere men with limitations. The heavenly Father knows no limits. The hymnist said, "His love has no limits, His grace has no measure, His power has no boundary known unto men; for out of His infinite riches in Jesus, He giveth, and giveth, and giveth again." This is the Father that extends His personal invitation to you. Jesus said, *"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."* His rest is eternal life with the Father who gave His people as a gift to His Son to be redeemed through His sacrificial death. Come to Him and He will claim you as His own. God will be your Father too.
